

Happy Friday Woodland Families,

We continue to plan for students returning to campus soon! Please see below for some important dates and details outlined below:

September 29th – First day back for KITE students who will attend school at Woodland Tuesday-Friday each week. Online/at home learning will continue on Mondays.

October 6th – First day back for Kindergarten and 1st grade students who will attend school from 9:15-3:36 Tuesday-Friday each week. Students will continue online/at home learning on Mondays, including a class meeting at 10:15 a.m.

October 13th – First day back for students in grades 2-6 who will attend school from 9:15-3:36 two days each week and will continue online/at home learning the other three days. Students will be assigned to an A or B schedule and attend on Tuesdays & Thursdays or Wednesdays & Fridays. We are working hard to keep siblings on the same schedule and to accommodate individual family needs as well.

With families across the district choosing to continue online learning for their children right now, we are in the process of combining some classes and in some cases reassigning teachers to teach at different grade levels. This is something that happens in schools every year, but having some students returning to Woodland part time, some students returning full time and others choosing to continue at home learning, there are more changes than what is typical. We will communicate any changes to your child's teacher assignment as soon as we can. Families of students in grades 2-6 returning on a hybrid model will soon learn if their child/ren have been assigned to schedule A {Tuesdays/Thursdays} or schedule B {Wednesdays/Fridays}. Thank you for your patience as we continue to navigate this challenging time.

When students return to campus there will be changes to our before and after school procedures.

Arrival:

- Students and parents **may not** arrive on campus prior to 9:05 a.m. and must remain in vehicles until signaled by our staff.
- Students enter the building through the front doors/bus doors and apply hand sanitizer to hands prior to walking to class.
- Students are expected to wear face masks throughout the school building, including common hallways, restrooms and classrooms.
- All parents and family members are prohibited from entering the school building.

Dismissal:

- Staggered release of students to ride the bus/parent pick-up for physical distancing.
- Students in grades K-2 and all siblings who are parent pick-up will meet in the front parking area.
- Students in grades 3-6 who are parent pick-up will meet in the bus loop area

Free 5-Day Supply of Student Meals - The next pickup is 11-12 on Monday, September 28th in front of the school. This is a drive-up service.
