Here are a few items to share with you:

- **Important – Action Required!** - As we continue to plan for a transition to hybrid learning model in the near future we need to know if you plan for your Woodland student(s) to return physically to campus or if you would like to continue distance/online learning. Families identified as the primary contact in eSchoolPlus has received an email from *Puyallup School District – Choose Your Learning Model* earlier today asking you to complete a survey, so we know how to plan for your child/ren. **The deadline to complete this survey is 9pm on Monday, September 14th.** If you do not complete the survey your child/ren will default to in-person instruction 2 days a week.
